DAY 1 - SPLIT - TROGIR

As you step aboard, indulge in a refreshing welcome cocktail and soak in breathtaking panoramas that unfold during the cruise towards Trogir. Explore the ancient Roman Forum, the iconic basilica of St. Donatus, and the imposing city walls adorned with the historic Port and Land Gates. Wander through the labyrinth of palaces and villas once inhabited by noble families and soak in the vibrant atmosphere of the city centre. Discover Zadar's contemporary marvels: the mesmerizing Sea Organ, a unique installation that harmonizes with the rhythms of the sea, and "The Greeting to the Sun," a spectacular light installation.
